In the last two months we have had a flurry of guests come to visit us. It has been a blessing and we are very grateful for it.

First, a young man, Primož, who ironically spent time studying at Oklahoma State University, dropped in on us. He *happens* to be a friend of the son of one of our faithful members. I mentioned in the last letter that one of the ladies who is faithful in the church is Chinese and that she has a Chinese ladies outreach that meets in our building. She asked me if I would begin meeting with the her and three other ladies that organize the fellowship. I am going through some lessons on biblical leadership with them and will be preaching to the whole fellowship in a few weeks. **Please pray for those who will come to this meeting.** There will be Chinese ladies who are scattered all across Slovenia; some are believers, some are not, so we want to challenge them about Jesus; who He is and what He has done for each of them.

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The **Cook family** has submitted their residency paperwork to the embassy of Slovenia. We are asking God to give them favor with the decisionmakers at the embassy so that they can begin the process of moving here to Slovenia. **Please pray for this process.** We also have another family coming to visit in November; the **Schnell family**. They got a burden for Slovenia and have begun raising support to come here. They had previously been missionaries in Cambodia but most recently had been working at BBTI in Texas. **Pray God gives them a vision of where they will settle when they arrive.**
